<p>48 Abell Street Toronto, ON</p>	<p>A 19th century factory currently a vibrant live/work space for artists, is threatened with demolition.</p> 	<p>DEATH SENTENCE</p>
<p>Central Pentecostal Tabernacle Edmonton, AB</p>	<p>One of many examples of landmark church buildings across the country at risk due to dwindling congregations and church politics forcing their closure and sale.</p> 	<p>DEMOLISHED</p> <p>Modernist landmark lost to make way for condo development</p>
<p>Creston Downtown Grain Elevators Creston, BC</p>	<p>Main Street landmarks that vividly communicate Creston's agricultural heritage at risk of demolition</p> 	<p>POSITIVE OUTLOOK</p>
<p>Herschel Island (QIKIQTARUK) Yukon</p>	<p>Herschel Island, containing many 100-year-old whaling industry buildings and the site of a National Historic Event, is threatened by melting permafrost and rising water levels.</p> 	<p>STILL AT RISK</p>

<p>King Building 104 King Street Winnipeg, MB</p>	<p>The King Building, a prominent 19th century warehouse in the Exchange District National Historic Site, has been derelict since 1991 and is slowly being demolished by neglect.</p> 	<p>STILL AT RISK</p>
<p>Royal Canadian Legion Building Saskatoon, SK</p>	<p>The Royal Canadian Legion Building, an important gathering place built by veterans in 1929</p> 	<p>DEMOLISHED</p>
<p>Seal Island Lighthouse Seal Island, NS</p>	<p>Seal Island Lighthouse, the oldest wooden lighthouse in Nova Scotia, falling into ruin due to lack of maintenance by its federal custodian</p> 	<p>STILL AT RISK</p>
